



Reception – Plants, Growth and Minibeasts- Knowledge Mat

Earthworm	A type of worm found in soil.		<input type="checkbox"/> What do plants need to grow?
Slithery	A smooth, slippery way of moving.		<input type="checkbox"/> How do worms help the plants to grow?
Grit	Small loose bits of stone or sand.		<input type="checkbox"/> Learn the names of a variety of plants/vegetables/minibeasts.
Rotting	Something that becomes weak due to decay. Example: Experiment by leaving a half-eaten apple on the side for a few hours.		<input type="checkbox"/> How do some animals change? Life cycles. (Frog, butterflies, chickens/ducks)
Wiggly	Wavy lines.		<input type="checkbox"/> Order life cycle changes.
Worm Cast	Worm poo! Worms leave their castings which are packed full of nutrients for the soil.		<input type="checkbox"/> Compare and discuss features of different minibeasts. Worms, spiders, bees and caterpillars.
Recycle	Changing waste into something useful.		<input type="checkbox"/> Understand and explore vocabulary relating to topic... Growth, seeds, leaves, flower, stem, life cycle, emerge, chrysalis, adult, young, hatch, eggs, hatch, insect, stages.
Tunnel	An underground passageway.		
Dangerous	Something that is going to cause harm or an injury.		
Skin	Skin is the soft tissue covering your body. Worms have skin just like us.		
Stamped	Giant steps hard on the ground.		
Disappear	Something has gone. It has vanished. You can't see it anymore.		
Bristles	A very short hair on an animal's skin. They help the worm to move.
