Writing Root: Jim and the Beanstalk by Raymond Briggs. At the start of the sequence, children discover a beanstalk and giant footprint in the classroom and use this to learn the story and retell it to one another. They will move on to using their knowledge of the sequel to initially innovate and then create their own sequel to another well-known fairytale, e.g. Auburn Hair and the Three Bears. During the sequence they will also consider the point of view of the 'villain' in the story and write a letter in role to the main character.
