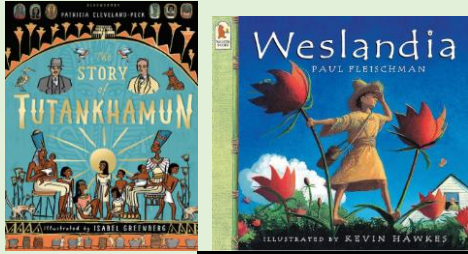

## Science: Sound

Identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating;  
Recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear;  
Find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features off the object that produced it;  
Find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it;  
Recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.

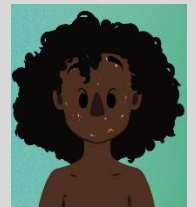
